## **Activities of the year**

*Activities and programs are integral part of the organization. Here we would like to put down the activities and programs of Sagara Education Development Society for the year. All these programs had been organized by the expertise of its members and volunteers under the leadership and guidance of the board members of SEDS.*

## **COVID-19 and its Impact:**

In India, around 250 million students were affected due to school closures at the onset of lockdown induced by COVID-19. The pandemic posed several challenges in public and private schools which included an expected rise in dropouts, learning losses, and increase in digital divide. The pandemic also called into question the readiness of the systems, including teachers to address such a crisis and sustainability of private schools. However, COVID-19 also acted as a catalyst for digital adoption in school education. With schools reopening in many states, it is important that a careful strategy is built in to smoothen the transition of children back to school after more than 15 months of home-based learning. This transition has to consider the learning losses



which had happened over the previous year as well take a futuristic approach to build a resilient system which can withstand any future shocks. NEP 2020, and subsequent government initiatives such as National Digital Education Architecture (NDEAR) and National Initiative for Proficiency in Reading with Understanding and Numeracy (NIPUN Bharat) are expected to provide a blueprint for this transformation. The paper is a culmination of CII School Summit 2021 which brought together policy makers, industry heads, and service providers together on a platform to deliberate on the road to recovery for schools post the pandemic. It analyses the impact of the pandemic across five themes and maps the various initiatives undertaken by governments and civil society organizations to address the challenges: poverty, while the number of undernourished people, currently estimated at nearly 690 million, could increase by up to 132 million by the end of year..

You and I are witness of thousand of lives lost during the second wave; as a matter of fact children are the most affected, orphaned or left with single parent, no source





of livelihood and above all no education since 2 years. Now though schools are getting opened but still thousand of Rural Tribal and Dalit community children are out of school. Try to support to bring these children to regular schooling.

**Education kit Distribute to Linganamakki School Children :**

Linganamakki School was started 1957 so many tribal village children are depending on this school above 95% Tribal children are studying in this school so we choose this school and distribute the School Bag, Pen, Note book, Sharpner, Eraser etc.. full education kit. Children are very happy to receive the gift and promise us to continue their studies.



**Education Kit Distributed to Remote village children:** the second phase of Education kit distribution to Bidaruru, Branama Ilakalalle, Indrodi Mane School Children with the

Navajeevana Rainbow Home Children and Share with Smart works team and collect the all gift and distribution to the children once there receive the gift there face was grow with smile and sharing there happiness to there peers group. "Happiness doesn't result from what we get, but from what we give" the really meaning we see from that children faces.



**Surprise gift to Destitute boys:** The Joy of giving we celebrate with Need base india boys from Shanthinagar. Boys are enjoy the gift like school bags, cricket bats, ball, sport martials etc., they all are very happy about the surprise gift.



**Destitute School Dropout Survey:** Covid-19 Pandemic effect so many children are dropout specially migrant workers so SEDS organization organized Destitute Children survey with the support of St.







Joseph Collage students we did the survey in Bangalore – JD Mara, LR Nagar Slum, Ejipura, K.R. Market, and other places more then 60 School dropout children we identified and submit the report to Education department.

**2 Lakh worth Medicine Distributed to Aralagodu PHC:** Every year for the months from November to May the villagers are affected by Kyasanuru Forest Disease (KFD). It is locally known as “Mangana Kahile (Monkey Fever)”. More than 300 people have died by this fever. 30 villagers have lost their lives in the year 2018 alone. Around 300 to 1000 villagers are losing their lives every year in these 91 villages located in this forest area. The people in these villages are



facing this Kyasanuru forest Disease (KFD) one side and another side facing the issue of wild life animals. As per Aralagodu Primary Health Center Dr Request we collaborate with The

Billon Hearts Beat Foundation Donated around 2 lakh worth 18 types of medicines. This medicine will help so many tribal community people specially Women’s and children.

**SHG Group Training :** SEDS organizing the SHG group training for women’s for various topic like Micro finance, Leadership, Stage program leaders.





Around 10 SHG group women's are benefited to this program. Our Aim is support more women's to develop there economic and leadership skills all so women's should come main stream.
